## Current Class Offerings at Always in Stitches January through April 2010

**Complete Quilting for Beginners** – In five classes Patty will guide you through the entire process from fabric selection, rotary cutting, and piecing to quilting and binding a 54-inch square lap quilt. – Tuesdays Mar 9, 16, 23, 30, Apr 13, 6-8pm \$40.00

Supplies for the first class:

- rotary mat, ruler & cutter
- fabric – bring with you to first class
  - center square – 3/8 yard bright
  - 3 dark fabrics – 3/8 yard + 3/8 yard + 5/8 yard
  - 3 light fabrics – 1/4 yard + 3/8 yard + 3/8 yard
  - Border – 1 1/4 yard (can be same as center)
  - Binding – 1/2 yard (can be same as border)
  - Backing –
    - § all one fabric – 2 5/8 yards
    - § scrappy – 1 3/4 yards

**Start Quilting Sampler** – This class is the next step after Complete Quilting for Beginners. You will learn more about fabric selection and will practice accurate rotary cutting and piecing. Create classic blocks and assemble them into a 40-inch sampler top with borders. Teacher: Patty Estadt. Thursday Jan 21, 28 Feb. 4, 25 Mar 4, 18, 6-8 pm \$ 40

**T-Shirt Quilt** – Collect memorable t-shirts and combine them into a memory quilt that can go along to college. Choose the size to make based on how many t-shirts you collect. Tues Feb 9 & 23, 6-8 p.m. \$20.00

Supplies:

- Prewashed t-shirts
- Light weight fusible interfacing (about 1/2 yard per shirt)
- Large square rotary ruler if you have one
- Rotary mat and cutter
  - There are patterns and books that are available, but not required. We will have these for you.

**New Girl Bag**– This hipster bag pattern by Tammy Tadd Design is a useful size and has great pockets and an easy magnetic closure. The sample was made with fusible fleece and all one fabric for the outside. The first class will cover cutting and quilting the fabric. The bag will be assembled during the second class. Sundays Feb 21, 28, 1 – 3 p.m. \$20.00

Supplies:

- Pattern
- Fabric listed
- Fusible fleece
- Thread to match fabric for quilting
- Machine with walking foot and guide if available
- Rotary tools (ruler, cutter, mat)

**Beginning Machine Quilting** – Learn to layer and mark quilts. Make samples of straight line and free motion quilting. Sunday Jan 30 noon – 4 p.m. **OR** Sun April 11, noon – 4 p.m. \$20.00

Supplies for class:

- sewing machine with walking foot and free motion-darning foot
- thread and wound bobbins
- pencil
- ruler
- 4 to 6 “quilt sandwiches” for practice – about 12” squares of batting with fabric on top and bottom. Safety pin together.
